ROBBEN ISLAND COMBO TOUR



The Cape Town Townships Tour including Robben Island, gives visitors an overview of South Africa's past and present. The full-day small group guided tour includes a round-trip ferry ride to Robben Island, a visit to Cape Town's District Six Museum, and the communities of nearby townships of Langa and Gugulethu.

Visit some of the notorious townships of Cape Town, including District Six, and learn more about South Africa's apartheid policies. Then, visit Robben Island, where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned.

Learn about life under apartheid in some of the townships
Visit the townships of Langa, Bonteheuwel and Gugulethu
Meet a traditional African healer, see local beer being made and visit a primary school
Get the chance to support local businesses and markets

For nearly 400 years, Robben Island in Table Bay, was a brutal prison where Nelson Mandela spent 18 years in a tiny cell during the apartheid era. Today, the island is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and a must-see attraction for anyone interested in South African history. Tours to the island begin with multimedia exhibits in the museum at the Nelson Mandela Gateway on the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront before travellers board vessels to the island. The boat trip takes about 30 minutes to an hour depending on weather conditions and can be rough during big swells.

While on the island, visitors tour the maximum-security prison, Mandela's former cell, and the lime quarry where prisoners were forced to endure back-breaking labour. The interesting part about the tour is that the guides are former prisoners of Robben Island who share their experiences and offer insight into the atrocities of apartheid and the power of forgiveness.

After leaving this hellish six-square-kilometre island, Mandela said, "As I walked out the door toward the gate that would lead to my freedom, I knew if I didn't leave my bitterness and hatred behind, I'd still be in prison." These wise words are even more potent after a tour here.

Pickup is available from hotels, guesthouses and accommodation within 10 kilometers of the city center. Pick-up time depends on your hotel location.

TABLE MOUNTAIN & CHAPMAN'S PEAK DRIVE GUIDED TOUR



At the upper station of the cableway, a café features a small viewing terrace and serves as the starting-point of three short walks, which highlight the gigantic scale of the landscape. For superb views of Table Mountain and the best vantage point to photograph this iconic landmark, hike or drive-up Signal Hill or Lion's Head - both offer stunning views from their summits.

The park protects an astounding diversity of plants and more than 1,470 flower species-the planet's richest floral kingdom-as well as animals such as cute snub-nosed dassies (rock hyraxes), caracals, and baboons. Within the park, Devil's Peak flanks the mountain on the east, and Lion's Head on the west, while the crags known as the Twelve Apostles loom over the beach resorts on the Atlantic coast.

A layer of clouds, called the "tablecloth" frequently cloaks the mountain's peak, but when the clouds clear, visitors can enjoy spectacular views of Cape Town and the entire Cape Peninsula from the summit. Bring a sweater as it can be cold and windy at the top.

Start your full-day tour at the Bo Kaap (Cape Malay Quarters) with its colourful houses, before heading to the Table Mountain cable car station. Take the cable car to the top for unforgettable views. Drive along the Atlantic coast, stopping at Maiden's Cove for photos with the backdrop of the 12 Apostles Mountain range. Enjoy the views from Chapman's Peak Drive, one of the world's most scenic routes. Visit Boulders Penguins Colony in Simon Town before reaching the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve.

Enjoy a guided tour at this very popular landmark. Travel to Cape Point, where you can hike to the top of the lighthouse or take the Flying Dutchman funicular to the top.

FULL-DAY WINERY TOURS



Spend the day exploring some of Cape Town's best wineries on a private wine tour complete with lunch. Visit a total of 4 wineries, sampling wines at each stop along the way. Join a full-day tour through Cape Town's wine country.

Start your Cape wine adventure with a convenient morning pickup from your accommodation in Cape Town. Hop on board an air-conditioned vehicle and head to your first stop on the tour, the Groot Constantia Vineyard.

Sample five selected wines, each one perfectly paired with a handcrafted chocolate. And before you leave for your next stop, visit the historical Cape Dutch homestead, and get a glimpse of what life on this wine farm was like in the 17th century.

Travel from Groot Constantia to the Steenberg Farm, home to some of South Africa's finest award-winning wines. Enjoy your second wine tasting of the day and get to sample six of the estate's very best wines from their flagship range. The next stop on your private wine tour is a boutique wine estate located on the slopes below Constantia Nek with magnificent views of the surrounding wine region and False Bay. Sit back and enjoy a delicious lunch at the Constantia Glen wine estate before taking part in your next tasting on the veranda.

The fourth and final stop on your winery adventure is Eagle's Nest located in the heart of the Constantia Valley. Enjoy the last tasting of the day in a picturesque setting beside a stream under the canopy of oak trees. End your day admiring fantastic views as you make your way back to Cape Town with a drive along the side of Table Mountain.

ROBBEN ISLAND BY AIR SCENIC HELICOPTER FLIGHT



Take a scenic helicopter ride to Robben Island for an unrivalled viewing experience. Circumnavigate the island and get great aerial views of the prison where Nelson Mandela spent 18 years of his incarceration. See postcard views of the city en route back.

Make your way to the V&A Waterfront Helipad to check in about 15 to 20 minutes before your scheduled shared helicopter flight over the city and coast.

Check out what sea life looks like under a microscope, and explore the Indian Ocean. View mesmerising exhibits that features the dazzling colours of its fish, translucent jellies, shy octopuses and Knysna seahorses. Make a point to check out the new I&J Exhibit, a 10-meter-long tunnel that gives a peek at a variety of subtropical species.

Once airborne you leave the city behind you as you soar over the Atlantic Ocean and head straight for the historical Robben Island. Your pilot will confidently navigate the helicopter around the island enabling you to experience the best possible views of the prison, the village and all else that is so unique on it.

En route back to the mainland you will get to view the picture-perfect combination of Cape Town and Table Mountain with Lion's Head and Camps Bay in the distance. As you descend for landing you fly over the working harbour of Table Bay and get one last look at Table Mountain.

Learn how to mimic nature's way of building soil fertility – it's easier than you think and so good for your garden. See exactly how to make and maintain compost heaps; understand carbon and nitrogen ratios, and find out how to brew fascinating micro-organism inoculants.

Enjoy award-winning wine paired with innovative food at our tasting room on the banks of the Spier dam. Join us for a wine tasting in our airy Tasting Room or a food platter and glass of wine on our shady stoep which has gorgeous mountain and dam views. Settle in and admire the iconic Heath Nash chandelier - made from 334 recycled Spier wine bottles and weighing 370kgs - which hangs above the tasting counter. You can either enjoy a set wine tasting (see the list below), with or without a food pairing, or order whatever you like with an olive, cheese or cured meat board.

The Eagle Encounters has been going strong since 2001, rehabilitating and releasing birds of prey, promoting conservation and education, on land donated by Spier. Birds of prey keep the farm's ecosystem in balance, making it possible to naturally control pests, without pesticides.

Enjoy up-close-and-personal interactions with eagles, hawks, falcons, owls, kites, buzzards, snakes and lizards. Take part in heart-stopping falconry displays, where we fly birds to you.

PENGUINS AND WINE TASTING TOUR *B*



Travel past Clifton and Camps Bay, Hout Bay, Chapman's Peak Drive, and Slangkop Lighthouse. Feed ostriches, see Cape Point, get up-close with penguins at Boulders Beach, lunch at Simon's Town and enjoy wine tasting in Constantia Valley.

Highlights

Visit Cape Point in Table Mountain Nature Reserve and let the Flying Dutchman Funicular transport you up to the lighthouse. Travel along one of the most spectacular roads in the world, Chapman's Peak Drive.

Have a drink at Cape of Good Hope, the most southwestern point of Africa.

Get up-close to the penguin colony at Boulders Beach near Simon's Town.

Treat your taste buds to award-winning wines of the Constantia Valley wine route.

Get picked up at 8:00 AM from your centrally located Cape Town city hotel or lodging in order to start the Cape Peninsula Tour. Travel around the beautiful Atlantic coastline, past the world-famous Clifton and Camps Bay Beaches, Bakoven, Llandudno and through Hout Bay.

Continue along the world-renowned magnificent Chapman's Peak Drive towards Kommetjie, a great surf spot, the Slangkop Lighthouse, past Misty Cliffs and continuing through the quaint seaside village of Scarborough until heading to Cape of Good Hope in the Table Mountain National Park. Be served complimentary tea/ coffee and biscuits at the much photographed Cape of Good Hope sign-board before driving further to eventually hop onto the Flying Dutchman Funicular (cost included) to go up to the incredibly beautiful viewing point around the base of the old Cape Point lighthouse.

Your next exciting stop will be Boulders Beach, a popular tourist destination, to view a colony of African penguins that settled there in 1982. Boulders Beach is one of the few sites where the penguins can be observed at close range, wandering freely in a protected natural environment. Boardwalks will take you to within a few yards of the birds.

After Lunch it's through Glen Cairn, Fish Hoek, Kalk Bay and over Boyes Drive for a panoramic view of False Bay, where you may be lucky enough to spot sharks or whales on a quick stop to the Shark Spotters lookout.

Not far from here you reach the Constantia Valley Wine Route, one of 9 routes in South Africa. You will be treated to a tasting of 5 fine wines at one of the finely selected estates on route. Then for a scenic drive back to your hotel past Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens which you can visit at your own leisure by taking the city sightseeing hop-on hop-off bus or an Uber from the city.

Embark on a private full-day Cape Agulhas tour and see the Southernmost tip of Africa - the official meeting point of the two oceans. Eat seafood fresh from the ocean, see the penguins, enjoy a wine tasting, and spot a whale in Hermanus.

Guests will be collected at their accommodation by a qualified tour guide in a luxury private vehicle. Embark on a journey to the southernmost tip of Africa where the two oceans meet, and explore Cape Agulhas and other towns along the route. This is one of the most beautiful tours one can experience.

Stop at Stony Point to view the African Penguins colony, one of the largest colonies of penguins in the Cape. If it is during whale season, you will have an option to do some whale-watching in Hermanus.

It is recommended that you enjoy lunch (not included) at one of the restaurants in Hermanus, or at the seaside. After lunch, make your way to Cape Agulhas, where you will walk the pathway that leads to the official meeting point of the two oceans (Indian and Atlantic oceans) and take some photos.

From there, explore the lighthouse, which is one of the oldest in South Africa and situated at the southernmost tip of Africa. Pass through some small towns along the route back to Cape Town, where guests will be dropped off at their accommodation or a restaurant for dinner.

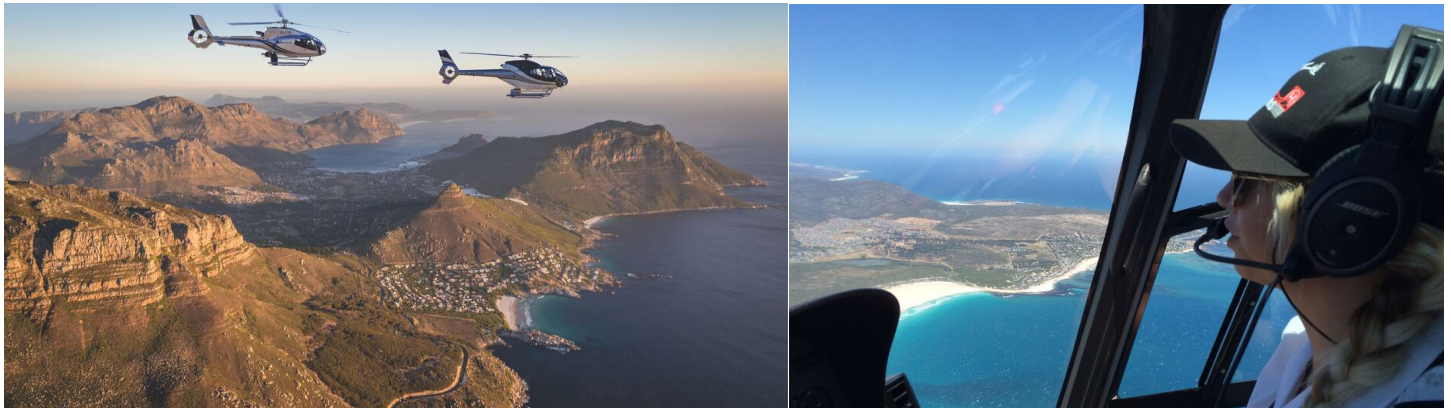

CAPE PENINSULA SCENIC HELICOPTER FLIGHT



Get bird's eye views of the Cape Peninsula on a scenic helicopter flight from Cape Town. Journey down the coast to the Cape of Good Hope and see the 12 Apostles Mountain range.

Take off from the V&A Waterfront Helipad for spectacular views of the "Mother City" and Table Mountain.

Glide over the venue for the 2010 World Cup, and then travel down the coast for bird's eye views of Lion's Head, Camps Bay and the beaches of Clifton.

Head for Karbonkelberg Mountain and soar over Hout Bay towards the Cape Nature Reserve.

Take photos of the Cape of Good Hope and watch as the terrain changes as you approach False Bay and look for great white sharks in the ocean.

Return on the other side of Table Mountain for a different view of the landscape, passing the vineyards of Constantia Valley before landing back at the helipad.

In optimal weather conditions take the opportunity to fly the paraglider yourself! Your instructor will place his hands above yours to show you how to steer. It really is quite simple and utterly exhilarating. This, like the aerobatics before landing, is completely optional of course!

The tour providers have a proven safety record from day one, a credit to company procedures. Each season starts with brand new equipment and well-maintained throughout the year. All pilots are internationally recognized Tandem Flight Instructors.

Each passenger is briefed and issued with a helmet. All pilots carry complete reserve and communication systems and weather conditions are carefully assessed before you are taken up and again on take off. You will be assisted by the crew on both take off and landing.

CASTLE OF GOOD HOPE AND CITY TOUR



Enjoy a half-day tour of Cape Town's main sites and landmarks, including Company Gardens, the Castle of Good Hope, the South African Museum, and the Parliament buildings. Visit the Bo-Kaap district, see Green Market Square, go to Signal Hill, and more

A Cape Town landmark, the Castle of Good Hope, is a prime example of a "star fort". The Castle of Good Hope is the oldest surviving stone building in South Africa. It was built in 1666-1679 as the residence of the Governor and for the protection of the early settlers, but the castle, which is in the form of a five-pointed star, was never exposed to attack. A highlight here is the William Fehr Collection, which includes pictures, porcelain, fine glass, ceramics, and furniture of the 17th to 19th centuries from South Africa, Europe, and Asia.

Cape Town, the Mother City, is a beautiful place steeped with history. This half-day tour will take you to all of the major points of interest and landmarks you need to see for your visit to be complete.

The tour will be led by a registered guide who is an expert on all things Cape Town. You will visit all the major sights in the city, including the South African Museum and beautiful Company Gardens. See the Parliament buildings, City Hall, and the Castle of Good Hope.

Before you reach the colorful streets of Bo-Kaap, the smells of Malay curry will be wafting your way. You will also visit the Green Market Square, Signal Hill, Camps Bay, and Clifton. If you are interested you will have the unique opportunity to be taken on a short diamond factory tour.

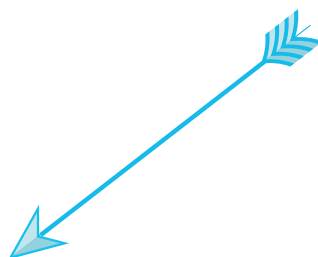
